Ah, the gentle burble of a garden fountain! It has a certain timeless charm, doesn't it? It's not just the preserve of stately homes or grand public gardens. With a dash of patience, a sprinkle of know-how, and an eye for design, you too can bring that touch of serenity to your own plot.

Many a time, whilst wandering the meandering pathways of my Hampshire home, I've paused by my own water feature, momentarily transfixed by its aquatic ballet. Yet, I remember the days when I would regard these structures with some scepticism, thinking, 'All that plumbing! All that fuss!' It's true that the construction of a water feature can be somewhat involved, but the rewards — both aesthetically and in terms of wildlife attraction — are undoubtedly worth it.

A well-designed water feature becomes the lifeblood of the garden. It draws in local wildlife, from birds seeking refreshment to frogs looking for a cosy nook. The sounds it produces can mask the ambient noise of urban life, transforming your garden into an oasis of calm.

However, before plunging headlong into the world of water features, it's wise to consider a few practicalities.

First and foremost, you have to think about the plumbing. Pipes need to be buried, but not too deeply; you don't want to run into trouble come winter when the ground freezes. The supply


> is another matter and while it might be tempting to tie it directly to your home's mains, this can prove costly. Instead, consider a recirculating system which will save on both water and your pocket.

In terms of style, it's essential to find a design that complements the surroundings. There's little sense in plonking a sleek, modern sculpture in the midst of a cottage garden or conversely, placing a rustic barrel in a space that is edgy and contemporary.

When I was planning mine, I took inspiration from the age of the house, the types of plants around and the overall 'feel' of the garden. Your water feature should enhance, not clash with, its environment.

And let us not forget maintenance. Algae blooms and the occasional mischievous leaf can plague water features.

Nigella's Turkey Hash

Introduction

She's the undisputable queen of Christmas, but Nigella Lawson doesn't just have you covered for the big day, she also knows exactly how to use up those Christmas lunch leftovers.

Though written as an actual recipe, the doyenne of dining makes it clear that the quantities are meant to be a guide only. They are more of the "a handful of this, a handful of that" school of cookery, allowing you to add your own specific brand of festive flair.



(serves 2 hungry people as a main course, or 4 with a baked potato and a green salad to go alongside)

- 50g flaked almonds
- 15g butter
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 1 onion, peeled and chopped
- 2 red peppers, deseeded and chopped
- 1 clove garlic, peeled and minced
- 250g shredded cold turkey
- 75g pitted black olives
- 2 tbsp soured cream
- 2 tbsp leftover turkey stock
- 1 eaa
- A few dashes of Tabasco sauce, or to taste
- 75g grated Parmesan
- 1–2 tbsp chopped flatleaf parsley to garnish (optional)


Method

- 1. Toss the flaked almonds in a hot, dry pan over a medium to high heat until toasted. Remove to a plate for a while.
- 2. Add the butter and oil to the pan, then throw in the chopped onions and peppers and cook, stirring, over a medium to low heat for about 10 minutes.
- 3. Stir in the garlic, then add the shredded turkey and cook until piping hot. Return the reserved toasted flaked almonds to the pan, add the olives and mix in.
- 4. Whisk together the soured cream, turkey stock and egg, then pour into the pan, give a quick stir to combine and shake in the Tabasco sauce.

5. Finally, add the grated Parmesan and stir until it begins to melt into the hash. On serving, sprinkle with chopped parsley, if wished.



 Channel your inner Nigella and feel free to make whatever swaps necessary to suit your tastes and provisions at hand. No turkey? No problem, shredded gammon would work just as well.

Do I need Lasting Powers of Attorney?

If you lose capacity and can no longer make decisions for yourself, there is no automatic right in law for your family, friends, or next-of-kin to make the decisions that you no longer can. Without Lasting Powers of Attorney in place, those that must make those decisions have to apply to the Court of Protection to be appointed your Deputy. This can take several months and cost thousands of pounds in legal fees and Court fees.

For this reason it is recommended that everyone should have Lasting Powers of Attorneys, to save their loved ones the time, expense and stress of a Deputyship application, and the ongoing costs associated with this.

There are two types of Lasting Power of Attorney:-

Financial Decisions LPA – Under this document you appoint one or more attorneys to make a decision on your behalf in relation to their property and affairs.

Health & Care Decisions LPA – under this document you appoint one or more people to make decisions on your behalf in relation to your personal welfare matters, health care and medical treatment including life sustaining treatment.

Financial Decisions

Attorneys appointed under a Financial Decisions LPA can make any decision you could make about your property and finances, such as buying or selling property and investments and managing bank accounts.

Attorneys can only make gifts from your money to relatives or charities in accordance with your previous habits. They cannot gift themselves, but can give gifts to those people that you might reasonably have benefited if available to do so i.e. family members.

You can also restrict what attorneys can do by stating in the LPA that certain things cannot be done and that certain helpful guidance be given to help the attorneys, for example "Do not sell my property until absolutely necessary".

Health & Care Decisions

Personal welfare decisions are those that relate to your welfare alone, such as medical treatment and decisions as to where you live and with whom. It stretches as far as

obtaining medical information and deciding what you wear, what you eat and how you spend your day. This can include a wish to stay in your home for as long as possible before being moved into

It is important to note that under this LPA the attorney(s) cannot make any decisions where you still have the capacity to do so yourself.

An important part of this LPA is your decision whether to let your attorneys decide whether to consent to life-sustaining treatment or to leave this decision with medical professionals.

With both LPAs, the you must have a level of capacity to create an LPA. If this is not present, the Court of Protection and the Office of the Public Guardian must become involved under a Deputy application. Deputy applications are far more costly and time consuming to set up and can also be stressful and burdensome on family members.

Summary

By creating LPAs you have peace of mind that if you lose capacity, you would know who is managing your affairs and that they would be fully aware of your wishes.

If you later wish to revoke your LPAs you can revoke them by serving a notice on your attorneys and sending this to the Office of the Public Guardian.

If you were to lose capacity and did not have LPAs in place, a Deputy may need to be appointed, and this would lead to large annual charges which would come out of your estate. However, while there are the initial costs of creating and registering LPAs, there are no ongoing costs at all.

Designer, writer and television presenter, Kevin McCloud leapt into our consciousness with his vastly successful Grand Designs show on Channel 4. This month, the affable architectural business owner talks about why horrendous setbacks can ultimately become a blessing.

The process of creating a home, whether from the skeletal remains of a renovation or the soil of a virgin plot, can often resemble a Shakespearean play: dramatic, filled with highs and lows and occasionally, a touch tragicomic.

It was John Steinbeck who once mused: "We value virtue but do not discuss it." Perhaps in the realm of architectural endeavour, it is not virtue we neglect, but the inevitable mishaps and misadventures.

Many a romantic soul has been lured by the poetic narrative of designing and constructing their dream home and while the end can indeed be a magnum opus of personal expression,

the journey is often punctuated by events that challenge, if not our sanity, then at least our patience and pocketbooks — not to mention the bank balance.

I've borne witness to countless architectural tragedies in my time – from the discovery of lurking damp beneath that 'perfect' Victorian wallpaper, to the devastating subsidence that can threaten a home's very foundations.

It's important – if not essential – to remember that architectural pursuits, like any creative endeavour, are vulnerable to the vagaries of fate. Acknowledging the possibility of such setbacks isn't pessimistic; it's pragmatic. Because more often than not it's not the setbacks themselves, but our reaction to them, that truly defines our architectural experience.

Recall the couple who unearthed a medieval well in what was to be their

contemporary kitchen extension. A disastrous discovery? To some, perhaps. Yet, they chose to embrace this artefact of history, turning it into a feature underlit glass floor, harmoniously marrying ancient history with modern design.

Or consider the family who found their chosen

roofing materials were no longer available, leading them to opt for an eco-friendly grass roof – unintentionally setting a trend in their locale.

In the scenic vistas of Bowness-on-Windermere lies a £1m eco-lodge, sporting a geodesic roof which I found utterly breath-taking: The Dome. It's a story rich with ambition and aspiration; Robert Gaukroger, once the proud owner, confessed: "It was an endeavour fuelled by my ego," speaking of this modern marvel cradled by the hillside.

After being caught in the quagmire of an eight-year land tiff, the structure sadly began to wear the marks of neglect. But as fate would have it, the tides turned when an undisclosed benefactor, later unveiled as Yvonne Malley, resurrected its charm, transforming it into an upscale questhouse.

It's tales like these that make me muse: perhaps there's room for a 'Grand Designs' offshoot – 'Woman Made Home', celebrating practical women mending the overreaches of ambitious men.

So, when you find yourself in an architectural pickle, take a breath, perhaps pour a glass of wine, and remember: the most compelling stories often come from the most unexpected detours.


